

Windows 95 - version A

1. To install the extranet client on Windows 95 version A, a **software patch** is required. It can be installed by clicking the **WIN 95 patch link (Msdun13.exe)** on the IP VPN customer website or CD. The installation for the patch is self-explanatory.
2. Download the Access Client from the IP VPN customer website or CD by clicking on its link.
3. If you are using Internet Explorer, after you click the file, choose run the file from its current location.
4. If you are using Netscape Navigator, save the file to your hard disk. After the download is done, open Windows Explorer, go to the directory where you saved the file, double click the file, and the installation procedure should start.
5. Installation walk through:
 - a. Use current install defaults - click next
 - b. License agreement - click next
 - c. Install in program files as "Deltacom" - click next
 - d. Install and run as application - click next
 - e. Settings review - click next
 - f. After install and the readme.txt - click next
 - g. Yes, I want to restart my computer now - click next
6. Client Configuration: after the client is installed the information below is should be entered manually.
 - a. Connection is any name you choose.
 - b. Description is the description of the connection.
 - c. The Dial-Up connection box can be left blank.
 - d. User Name is the user id provided to you by Deltacom.
 - e. Password is the password you provided to Deltacom.
 - f. The Destination is the location in the IP VPN network you are connecting to, this IP address (216.248.182.21) will be preloaded by Deltacom.
 - g. After all six steps above have been completed, launch the VPN connection by clicking connect.

Congratulations, you are finished!

NOTES:

- Windows 95 version A requires the software patch (On the IPVPN Website or CD) to be loaded prior to the Extranet Client Installation.
- The VPN Client will ONLY work if IPSEC tunneling is supported on the network from which you are connecting.
- If you are using any Third-Party Dial-Up Software, like America Online, CompuServe...etc., sign on then connect using the VPN client.
