

NOTICE AND EXPLANATION OF PROPOSED TARIFF FILING

October 16, 2008

DeltaCom, Inc. herewith gives notice of proposed revisions to its interexchange tariff as described below.

TX8-3013:

The purpose of this filing to the Alaska interexchange tariff, is to add language to clarify the computation of charges. DeltaCom has updated its rounding computation. If the charges include a fraction of a cent, the fraction is rounded up to the next whole cent. (e. g. \$1.523 would round up to \$1.53) on a per call basis.

This tariff was filed on October 20, 2008 with a requested effective date of December 1, 2008.
